**You can't run from God. (Ps 139:7-12)**

**You can't keep God from perfecting His will.**

**You can miss the Blessing of being a part of it.**

**Thus: Rebellion is an exercise in Futility**

**Rebellion is us Picking a Fight with God!**

*(Gal 6:7) Be not deceived; God is not mocked...*

Jonah, the son of Amittai, the prophet of God (2 Kings 14:25)

Served during the reign of Jeroboam II ~ 825-753 BC

100 years before Assyria invades the Northern Kingdom

**The Commission of Jonah: (vs 1-2)**

Nineveh was founded by Nimrod (Gen 10:11)

**The Flight of Jonah: (Vs 3)**

Nineveh was roughly 500 miles from Gath-hepher

Tarshish was ~ 2500 miles west, in the opposite direction.

***Jonah is Picking a Fight with God***

Jonah hated the Ninevites.

Ninevites were cruel people.

Known for their cruel tortures of burning people alive.

Filleting people alive, and other cruelties.

**The Pursuit of Jonah: (vs 4-5)**

The Sovereign God was disturbed (Vs 4a)

The Sea was disturbed (Vs 4b)

The Ship was disturbed (Vs 4c)

The Sailors were disturbed (Vs 5)

**Rebellion makes us oblivious to the plight of others (Vs 5)**

The Sailor's lost their living - could have lost their lives

Jonah Lost God's Voice (Is 59:1-2)

Jonah Lost his Spiritual Power

Jonah Lost his Desire to Pray

Jonah Lost his Testimony

(1 Sam 15:25) Rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft

**The Sailor's ask Jonah 7 questions (vs 6-11)**

*What meanest thou, O sleeper?*

*What is thine occupation?*

*Whence comest thou?*

*What is thy country?*

*What people art thou?*

*Why hast thou done this?*

*What shall we do unto thee?*

**Do you Really expect to win in a Fight with God?**
