<u>A Message of Accusation</u>: 3 Sins that Grieve God's Heart In Chapter 4: The fearless prophet "starts meddling" now and begins to name sins. He calls the women living in careless luxury "fat cows of Bashan."

See them telling their husbands to bring them more drinks.

2. Hypocrisy: Sacrilege of Israel (4:4-5)

3. Obstinacy: Stubbornness of Israel: (4:6-11) Amos is not impressed with the religion at Bethel; to him it is just another sin on their records. God had sent his warnings to them (v. 6-11), but they would not listen.

He had taken the best of their young men to die in war (4:10), but still the nation did not repent.
