## A. <u>A Loaded Question</u>. vs 25 - 28

- 1.) Lawyer's Question. vs 25
  - a.) Good question asked with a bad motive.
  - b.) He was not honestly inquiring of the way to heaven.
  - c.) Furnished Jesus with an opportunity to illustrate the value of love.
- 2.) Jesus responds with His own Question. vs 26 28
  - a.) What does the law say? vs 26
  - b.) Law says love God. vs 27, (Deut 6:5)
    - (1) We are to rely on God completely. Not ourselves. Mark 12:30
    - (2) We see here the starting of the end of the law. (vs 28)

## B. <u>A Loving Lesson</u>: Who is my neighbor? vs 29 - 37

- 1.) <u>Lawyer's Attitude is still wrong</u>. Justification is not in works. vs 29
- 2.) Certain man is typical of all men. vs 30
  - a.) He has no one but himself to blame for the problem in which he finds himself.
  - b.) He had made the decision to travel the road by himself.

- c.) He was left half dead but in reality he was half alive to the right care.
- 3.) Choosing to be a bad influence: (Vs 31-32)
  - a.) They both thought it better not to get involved. On the other side.
  - b.) They both set claims of the ceremonial law above those of charity. Deliberately avoided any possibility of contact.
  - c.) They did not care. He was a nuisance to avoid, so they ignored him.
- 4.) <u>Choosing to do the right thing</u>: (Vs 33-35)
  - The Samaritan was a neighbor to love and help,
  - a.) Compassionate: (vs 33) The love of God was in his heart.
  - b.) Care exercised. (Vs 34)
    - (1) Love becomes charity as it is put into action.
    - (2) Love will always be strengthened by action. One can say all he wants to but words put to practice express much more.
  - c.) Continued to look after him. vs 35
    - (1) He did more than the minimum.
    - (2) He saw a man in need and did all he could
