The Scorner rejects Wisdom, met with destruction (1:24-27) The Scorner listened to Folly & received destruction (6:32)

What Significance is there that the Simple are called 3 times? Simple that rejects Wisdom's call end up in hell: (Ch 9:18) Simple listening to Folly, ended up in Hell (7:27) (Matt 6:24)

2. The Wise has made up their also: (Vs 8b-10)

3. <u>Consequences are Unavoidable & Inescapable</u> (Vs 11-12)

III. Foolishness: (Vs 13-18)

1. <u>Foolishness has prepared a Banquet</u>: (Vs 13-15) The Fool listened to Folly & (5:22-23) received death. The Fool rejected wisdom & (Ch 8:36) experienced death.

2. Foolishness Call unto he Simple: (Vs 16)

(Ch 7:13-22) Folly has been busy inviting to her banquet also. (Ch 7:22) Like an Ox to the slaughter. (Ch 7:26-27) Folly offers Death.

If Folly was a real person, what would she be like? (Vs 13) living to fulfill her flesh. (Vs 14) Idle, not productive, a waster. (Vs 15-16) Wanting to ensnare others because to her is it fun.

But to ensnare those seeking Wisdom, she changes her

tactics: (Vs 16b-18) Folly always appeals to the Flesh, leads to death. (Ch 51:14).

IV. <u>The Motivating Thrust</u>: How do we keep from being fooled? *Walk in Wisdom. What does that Mean? How do we walk in Wisdom?*

Principle, Conviction, Standard. Yes, but how do you get someone to value this? Value it more than pleasure, Entertainment, Sleep?
