**<u>Title</u>**: The Lord's Personal Love

**<u>Text</u>**: (Hosea 14)

<u>The Future Restoration of Israel Upon Her Repentance</u> (14:1-9)

Hosea Magnifies the faithful love of God, in contrast to the unfaithfulness of God's people.

## I. A Call to Revival: (14:1-3) Now!

- A. Reason of Their Fall: (Vs 1)
  - 1. Their own iniquity.
- B. The Urgency of their Call: A Call to Repentance
  - 1. To Return. (Vs 1)
    - a. B/c they went their own way.
    - b. B/c they went in their own strength.
    - c. B/c they went in their own wisdom.
  - 2. To Pray (Vs 2)
    - (a) By deed, & not word only
    - (b) (James1:22; Ps. 78:35; Is: 29:13)
  - 3. To Praise: (Vs 2c)
    - (a) Not sacrifices but calves of lips. (Heb 13:15)
  - 4. Confession that their Schemes won't work: (Vs 3)
    - (a). Israel will renounce 3 besetting sins.
      - a. Trust in Assyria.
      - b. Cavalry of Egypt.
      - c. Idolatry.

## II. A Promise of Restoration: (14:4-9) Today!

- A. A Promise To heal their backsliding: (Vs 4)
  - 1. God can heal the most desperate sinfulness. A Promise of God's Blessing

- B. To love them freely. (Vs 4)
  - 1. True love (1 Jn 4:10)
  - 2. This brings Justification. (Rom 3:24)
- C. To be as dew: (vs 5-6)
  - 1. Results to be blessed as a lily. (Matt 5:28-29)
  - 2. Shall be rooted in the things of God.
  - 3. Beautiful:
- D. The return & blessings: (Vs 7)
  - 1. Israel to increase as corn. (John12:24)
  - 2. Israel to be grafted back in Roll: (Jn 12:23-25)

## III. The Millennial Response (Vs 8-9) Future!

- A. Ephraim will Confess their Sin: (Vs 8)
  - 1. In Millennium, they will totally repudiate idolatry.
  - 2. Israel will openly admit they have finally heard the word of their God and beheld His glory. (Previously Ignored for Personal Gain)
  - 3. Therefore, they will prosper like a vibrant fir tree.
  - 4. The fruit of God will be found in them.
    - a). The fruit of the Righteous: (Prov 11:30)
    - b). The fruit of the Spirit: (Gal 5:22-23)
    - c). The fruit of righteousness: (Phil 1:11)
    - d). Israel in that day will bring forth fruit to God.
- B. Book concludes with rhetorical questions. (Vs 9)
  - 1. The wise and prudent will understand:
  - 2. sense of 'upright' or 'straight':
  - 3. The righteous will walk in the upright ways of God:
    - a). Christ the foundation stone to some: (1 Pet 2:6)
    - b). A stone of stumbling of offense: (1 Pet 2:8) Quoting: (Is 8:14)
    - c). Future glorious event will take place
