1. The Payment for out Sin: (Jn 19:34)(Hebrews 9:22)
2. Prophesied in The brazen serpent: (Num 21:8-9)
Now The emblem of God's love: (Jn 3:14-15)
A Sign of Our Hope of Glory: (Col 1:21-27*) "Christ in you"
To the World, the Cross is Repulsive.
To the Believer, object of glory: (Gal 6:14b)
It is dead to us and we ought to be dead to it. (Rom 6:7-11)

- a) As Saul had alot to glory in Himself. (Gal 1:13-14)
- 2. The Power of the Cross: Vs 15) (John 3:3)
 - a) Liberty from Self: (Gal 2:20)

 - c) Liberty from the World: (Gal 6:14)

3. The Purpose of the Cross: (Vs 16) Believers today are not the "Children of Abraham" But they are "Abraham's Seed" through Faith.(Gal 4:28)

C. Paul, Himself: (Vs 17-18)

"Mark" Grk word - Stigmata – "brand marks" (Gal 6:17) Slaves of the Roman Empire were marked by their owners Greek word "stigma" – A mark of inferiority

- 1. <u>Saul of Ta</u>rsus was marked by Circumcision: and proud of it. (Phil 3:4-6)
- 2. Paul was marked in a different way: (Phil 3:7-11)
- **3.** <u>Paul affirmed his suffering for Christ's sake.</u> (Acts 4:12)(Ro 1:16) (2 Cor 12:7-10)
 - a) <u>Paul had the scars to Prove it</u>: (2 Cor 11:23-25)
- 4. <u>Heathens were branded with the symbol of their god or goddess.</u>
- 5. <u>Slaves were branded so everyone would know who his</u> <u>owner was.</u>
 - a) Paul was the slave of Jesus Christ, his scars were proof
 - b) Paul was proud to be a Slave to Christ. (Gal 1:10)

Paul is Not a boasting, but a defense of His Servanthood: (Gal 6:14, 17-18)

Paul's Scars showed the strength of his witness & the measure of his devotion. (2 Cor 4:10) An the appeal of Christ: (Rev 5:6,12) (Rev 13:8) The gospel message: (Is 53:3-5) Faith in Christ is a faith in His scars: (John 20:25-28)
