Jesus speaks to listening hearts - through His Word Still small voice, under all the other noise in your world. If you haven't heard Him lately, it's not b/c He isn't speaking. It's because We haven't paused to listen. Jesus Speaks to Those Who Are Still & Listening. Is your life fully immersed in the Christ of the Christmas Story?

<u>Jesus Guides Those Who, by Faith Trust Him -</u> <u>Imagine Being One the Wise Men!</u> MT 2:1-2; 8-11

Outsiders, Gentiles, perhaps least likely to anticipate, understand, or believe the prophecies of Messiah

They were men who Saw w/Eyes of Faith

They were men who Trusted w/Hearts of Faith.

They were men who Sought Him w/Unshakable Faith They left their homes, & followed their faith.

Jesus is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him He responds to our faith.

Men say, "show me and I'll believe."

God says, "Trust me and I'll show you!"

Have you exercised your Faith & Trusted Christ to be saved? (Jn 3:36a)

She was living a life of love & honor before God. She was Naive enough to avoid religious politics & She loved God enough to Be PURE.

God chose a person who would accept His plan. **Bottom line—She wanted Jesus!** - (Lk 1:28)

Not for political or Personal gain.

So it is today. Jesus manifests Himself & His will to those who have willing hearts who love Him.

He gives His Guidance, Strength, & Blessing to those who want Him & His will, w/o question.

He gives Himself to those who are Pure, Who Avoid the religious politics, & love Him in truth.

Besides the normal fatherly duty to protect Jesus from every day dangers, Joseph had King Herod & his army are on a search & destroy mission!

But we must have the good sense to Obey & Follow.

(Luke 2:25-32; 36-38)
