## **Training Through Trials** - Job 23:10 (8/9/17)

<u>Illus</u>: Exercise requires resistance to build physical strength. NASA-artificial resistance.

God uses resistance to exercise us to spiritual fitness 1 Ti 4:8 Life is not perfection, but progression or process.

Athletes train for Game Day, God trains us to perform also.

<u>Illus</u>: The Weights God uses are Trials/Struggles. **Job 23:10** 

Illus: With weight training, we always use a spotter to escape being crushed. In 2012-460K were injured.

Jesus is our spotter. "a way of escape" I Cor 10:13

## What Exercise is to Athletes; Trials are to Christians.

<u>Illus</u>: Chinese word for <u>"Crisis"</u> is the combination of the 2 words, "Danger" and "Opportunity"

We often see danger, But not opportunity. 1 Peter 1:7

Illus: Hayfield-2A-days: Trials are to the Christian what
Conditioning Practices are to the Football players.

In a Trial, God runs us through the drills of the Fundamentals

- I. <u>Expect the Trials</u>: (Jn 16:33) (1 Peter 4:12)
  - a. The Goal of Trials are Strength and Usability:

Illus: to create usable tools, the metal must be heated. Making a Screw Driver - Molded through Hammering. Fire Hardens – Friction Sharpens!

- b. Trials are for Chastising: Illus: Can we honestly say we are submitted & filled with the Spirit all the time?
- c. Not sure, ask the person sitting next to you, they will clear that up! (Heb 12:6,11) "Exercised Thereby"
- d. Trouble comes to Change Us or Chastisement!(1 Cor 11:30) God has to Train Us Like a Child!
- e. Discipline is Part of Training. (Prov 13:24)

- II. Excited by Trials: (I Pet 4:13) Don't run from them, Embrace Them!
  - a. <u>Be Excited, Trials Condition Us</u>: (2 Tim 2:3)
    It takes Heat to make metal strong. (*Hardness*)
  - b. <u>Be Exicited, Trials Conform Us</u>: (Acts 5:40-42) We Identify With our Savior! (Gal 6:17)
- III. Embrace the Trials: (1 Pet 4:15-16) Thank Him for It! He is working on us! (Phil 1:6)
  - a. Conforming us to be like Christ: (Rom 8:29)
  - b. God knows what we need to be usable: Molding Us (Rom 9:20-21) Friction makes the tools smooth/precise
- IV. Evangelize in the Trials: (I Pet 4:17-18)
  - a. Now is not the Time to quit! Be Real in the Trial!
- #1 Mechanical walk with God. Got Hurt, Correction Resistant
  - b. The World is Watching: (1 Pet 3:14-17)
  - c. (Jn 9:3) God's purposes are bigger than us/our situation "A faith that cannot be tested cannot be trusted"
  - d. If a Friend had cancer, would they come to you for Encouragement, Hope, Faith? (Eph 2:10)
- (Esther 4:14c) "who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"
- V. Earnest in the Trial: (1Pet4:19) "Commit"-Banking Term
  - a. God Promises Interest on your Investment of Faith:
    - i. (Is 49:15-16) God sees, God Rewards, You may not see it, but He does.
    - ii. (Rom 5:3-4) God uses trials to build upon our faith
- iii. (2 Tim 1:12) Commitment Giving it all to Him <u>Illus</u>: Everyone has Trials, We inherited Dysfunctionaliry, Adam/Eve: Broken Homes, Physical, Financial, Betrayal, Illus: Lodge Poll Pine! A Fire-dependent species

We are Trial-Dependent Species: It takes Trials to for us to bear fruit.
