(I Cor 1:26) **"not many mighty..."** (Zech 4:6) -**Bible Example:** David (I Sam 16:12)

C. <u>Pedigree</u> is Not Required. (I Cor 1:26) "not many noble, are called:" -Bible Example: Gideon (Judges 6:15)

God doesn't use us b/c of <u>Intellect</u>, <u>Influence</u>, or <u>Inheritance</u> No credit should be attributed to man.

B. <u>The Reality of Praise</u>. (I Cor 1:31) LORD, may I be:

- 1. Foolish enough to depend on Thee for wisdom.
- 2. Weak enough to be empowered by Thy strength.
- 3. Base enough to have no honor but Thy honor.
- 4. Despised enough to be kept in the dust at Thy feet.
- 5. Nothing enough for Thee to be everything.
