**Purpose**: Comfort the Afflicted, Afflict the Comfortable.

I. <u>The Anger (of the Lord)</u>: Nahum 1 God is Jealous II. <u>The Announcement</u> (of the fall): Nahu 2 God is Judge III. <u>The Activities</u> (caused the fall): Nahum 3 God is Just

You can imagine, how happy the people of Judah were Nineveh has fallen-The Assyrian empire has been broken

The Assyrian Army Came into N/Kingdom like a food. They were God's hand of judgment against his people.

(Nahum 2:1-5) Assyria was a ruthless, Brutal enemy Assyria had been used of God to chasten Israel; 721 BC.

Assyria tried to conquer Judah: 701 BC God intervened & destroyed their army (II Ki 18-29).

Nineveh destroyed by Medes/Babylonians 612BC The ruins of the city remained undiscovered until 1842!

## There was no hope for Nineveh;

Not a message of warning to Nineveh; they had heard God's warning from Jonah 150 years before. God's patience had run out and His judgment would fall.

<u>This was a message of hope for Judah</u>: to encourage them to trust God at an hour of great danger.

# I. THE ANGER of the Lord: Nahum 1 "God is Jealous"

Comfort from an Uncomfortable God.

### A. God Speaks of Himself: The Revelation (Nah 1:1-8)

- 1. The Lord doesn't overlook the evil that people do.
- 2. The Lord has promised to take care of His people.
- 3. Revenge will be expressed by the Lord.
- 4. This prophecy comforts God's people. (Nah 1:15)

#### B. God Speaks to Nineveh: (Nahum 1:8-11, 14)

- 1. The fall of Nineveh in 2 pictures:
  - a. A great flood of waters (vs 8)
  - b. A fire of dry thorns that burns (Vs 10a)
- 2. The fall of Nineveh's Leaders: (Vs 11, 14)
  - a. (2 Kings 18:17-22; 25, 28-31)
  - b. (2 Kings 18:32-35) Pride makes us go too far.
  - c. (2 Kings 19:6-7) Isaiah assures the King.
  - d. (2 Kings 19: 10-13) Sennacherib won't let it go.
  - e. (2 Kings 19:14-19) King of Judah responds
  - f. (2 Kings 19: 20-23) The Lord comforts Judah
  - g. (2 Kings 19:35\*) God slays 185K in one night.
  - h. (2 Kings 19:36-7) God slays Sennacherib

## C. God Encourages Judah: (Nahum 1:12-13, 15)

- 1. God makes two wonderful promises.
  - a. God assures them of His goodness (Vs 7)
  - b. God assures them that He loves them: (Vs 12)
- 2. The prophecy was the fall of Nineveh:
