- 4. Lord's Return & Resurrection of saints. (4:13-end)

Every Chapter has a reference to Christ's Return: (1:10) (2:19)(3:13)(4:13-18)(5:23) Every Chapter has a Great Evangelistic emphasis (1:8-10; 2:12-13; 3:12-13; 4:1-12; 5:1,6) Special Features of the city of Thessalonica:

Was Well organized church (1 Thes 5:12) Church was Predominately Gentiles. Suffered Persecution (1 Thes 2:14)

Possibly the 1st of the letters written by Paul Proclaims Christ as Lord. (23 Times)
Personally Encourage those facing Persecution: (1:6)
Warn Believer of Dangers of Sexual Impurity: (4:1-6)
Charge Believers w/practical rules of Behavior (5:12-

A. A Working Church with Faithful Ministers: (Vs

1) All 3 worked to found this church, (Acts 17) & continued to minister to it through visits & letters.

Paul visited 2nd time on his 3rd Journey (Acts 20:1-2) Timothy visited to help them: (1 Thes 3:1-6) All 3 ministers wrote the church twice: (I & 2 Thes)

B. <u>A Working Church of The People</u>: (Vs 1) The Church was the people. Every believer was equally important to God.

C. <u>A Working Church Founded on Jesus</u>:(Vs 1). (1 Cor 3:10-11) Jesus is the only Foundation & Head.

D. <u>A Working Church Possesses Grace & Peace</u> (Vs 1)

<u>Grace</u> = Undeserved favor and Blessings of God's <u>**Peace</u>**=Secure in God's Love: (Eph 2:13-14)</u>

E. <u>A Working Church is Stirred to Prayer</u>: (Vs 2) (Matt 21:22)(John 15:7)

- F. <u>A Working Church is Stirred Up to Work</u>: (Vs 3)
 - 1. Faith Stirs a Church to Work: (1 Jn 5:4-5)

1. <u>Believers are Chosen to be His beloved people</u>. Called to be separated <u>unto</u> Righteousness: (Eph 1:4)

2. <u>Believers are Chosen to be beloved brethren</u> Called to respect one another: (Jn 13:34-35)
