Simon witnessed Jesus' interaction with the crowd:

Prophesying of their Future: (Lk 23:27-31) In contrast to the Thieves (Lk 23:32-33) fulfilling prophecy (Is 53:12) and he was numbered with the transgressors; (Ps 22:16) they pierced my hands and my feet.

(Vs 34) Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; (Ps 109:4) (Is 53:12)

Simon Witnessed the Crucifixion: (Lk 23:34-38)(Vs 44-49) (Is 53:12)(Ps 22:18)(Ps 69:21)

<u>Simon Witnessed how Jesus Behaved toward the Jewish</u> <u>leadership</u>. (Ps 22:8)(Ps 22:17)

Simon Witnessed Jesus' interaction with the Thieves: (Vs 39-43)

Simon hears the unlikely witness of the 1st thief:(vs 40-42)

<u>Simon Witnessed the world go dark for 3 hours</u>:(Vs 44-45) (Amos 8:9)

Simon hears the unlikely Witness of the Centurion: (Vs 47)

Simon Sees the Reaction from the Jewish Leadership: (Vs 48-49) (Is 53:4)(Ps 38:11) (Acts 2:6-12 (* 10)

Simon Obviously goes home & Witnesses to his family: (Mk 15:21-22)(Rom 16:13)

There's a church now in Cyrene. (Acts 11:20) (Acts 13:1)
