#### A successful four-fold approach to Bible Study is:

- <u>Admit</u>: Be willing to open your heart to the Word of God.
- <u>Submit</u>: Accept what is written as a personal admonition.
- <u>Commit</u>: *Hide the Word of God in your heart until it becomes part of your life and experience.*
- <u>Transmit</u>: Pass on what you have received to others that they might also be blessed.
