## **The Temptation of Christ** – Luke 4:1-13

(Luke 4:1) *led up of the Spirit.* 

(Mark 1:12) the Spirit driveth Him into the Wilderness.

(Luke 11:4) "lead us not into temptation;"

## 1. The Lust of the Flesh: (Luke 4:2-4)

- a. He had fasted 40 days He was hungry.
  - i. The Devil attacks When we are weakest.
- b. Our Flesh Desires/lusts for fulfilment.
  - i. Fasting breaks the hold of the flesh
  - ii. To bring our flesh under control.
- c. Each temptation is Two-Fold in Nature.
  - i. To Fulfill our Desire instead of God's Desires:
  - ii. To Fulfill our Desires When We Want
- **d.** Jesus uses Scripture to overcome the temptation. (Deut 8:3) (Psalms 119:9, 11)
- **2.** The Lust of the Eyes: (Luke 4:5-8)
  - a. Is Jesus going to rule and reign on the earth?
  - b. Jesus uses Scripture: Deut 6:13)

  - **b. Jesus uses Scripture:** (Deut 6:16)

- a. God cannot Be tempted: (James 1:13)
- **b.** He had no Sin: (1 Jn 3:5)

- b. To Demonstrate Christ's Sinlessness:
- c. To Identify with us in testing: (Heb 4:15)
  - i. Same temptation as others: (1 Cor 10:13a)
  - ii. I'm not tempted more than I can handle w/ His help: (1 Cor 10:13b)
  - iii. I'm offered a Way of Escape: (1 Cor 10:13c)
  - iv. I can ASK for Help: (Heb 4:16)

Mercy: When I give in to my flesh in Self-Will

**Grace:** Supernatural Enablement to overcome temptation.
