1. <u>God uses judgment on Samaria as Judah'wakeup call to Judah</u>. (Ch 6:16)

#### B. Micah Speaks of His Sorrow: (Ch 7:1-7)

- 1. Confession of guilt by people or prophet, (Micah 7:1-6)
- a) How to approach God, inevitable punishment of the wicked.
- b) Cry of despair of Micah for his own people
  - The prophet laments moral collapse.

#### III. Because of God's Great Mercies, Trust the Lord: (Ch 7:7-20)

### A. The Voice of the Nation: (Ch 7:8-10)

1. Prayer of penitent, confession of faith, v. 8-9.

#### B. The Voice of the Prophet: (Ch 7:11-14)

1. Prayer of penitent, confession of faith, v. 7-13. Trust in God despite personal and national suffering. Enemies will be ashamed.

- a) Prophesied fall of Assyria, (Micah 5:5-6, 7:8)
  b) Prophesied Return from Babylonian Captivity. (ch 4:1-8; 13, 7:11, 14)
  c) Restoration and Final Triumph (Micah 7:11–20)
- d) Cities rebuilt, nations humbled.
- e) God's compassion and covenant love magnified.

## C. The Voice of the Lord: (Ch 7:15)

#### D. The Voice of the Prophet: (Ch 7:16-20)

- 1. Praise to Jehovah who restored them: (Ch 7:18)
  - a. Micah closes with praise: "Who is a God like unto thee,?"
  - b. Micah wants to bring the people to faith in the Lord,
  - c. Only God can forgive sins (Mk, 2:7; Ps. 32:5).
  - (Salvation, deliverance, loving kindness, forgiveness)
- 2. Prayer for renewed grace and deliverance vs 14-17
- 3. Praise to Jehovah who restored them, v. 18-20.
  - a. Redemption in the last days:
  - b. Assurance of fulfillment of covenant promises.
