I. <u>What is Salvation by Election</u>: (I Pet 1:2)(Eph 1:3)(Eph 1:11) It is true that saved people were elected from the beginning.

(2 Thes 2:13) "The Beginning." = (2 Tim 1:9)(Eph 1:4)(2 Pet 1:10)

- A. God's election is according to His foreknowledge. (Rom 8:29-30)
- B. God knows no time. (Rev 13:8)(Eph 1:4)
 God is a present-tense God: (Ex 3:13-14)
 This new nature that is in me is Christ in me. (Col 1:27)
 In the mind of God I was crucified with Christ. (Gal 2:20)
 My faith was counted for righteousness. (Rom 4:5)

Predicated upon God knowing I would accept Christ: (Rom 8:29, 30) Glorification of a Christian takes place at the rapture: (I John 3:2)

II. What Salvation By Election IS NOT

- A. Protestant world has 2 extremes: Calvinism & Arminianism
- **B.** Extreme Calvinists are identified with these teachings:
 - T -Total Depravity U -Unconditional Election
 - L -limited Atonement $I\,$ -Irresistible Grace
 - **P** -Perseverance of the Saints

No one is predestined for Heaven or Hell (Rom 8:29-30) Acrostic - T U L I P

Total Inability or Total Depravity – Man can't do anything about his situation, it is completely up to God and man cannot exercise free will in either direction; to accept Christ or Reject Him.

(John 3:16)(John 3:36)(John 10:9)

<u>Unconditional Election</u>–Pre-ordained before the foundation of the world. (Eph 1:4-5)(Matt 25:41)(Eph 1:12) How do I know this to be true? (Eph 1:13) gives the answer: (I Pet 1:2)

Limited Attonement – Only died for a select few ~ the *Elect*. The Calvinist uses (John 6:44) as their basis. This teaching is refuted by (John 12:32) *draw all men unto me.*" (Matt 20:28) "*Many*" vs "All" is refuted by (1 Tim 2:4-6) "*All Men*" (2 Pet 3:9) "*All*" (Lk 2:10) "*All People*". God is no respecter of persons: (Rom 3:22)

<u>Irristable Grace</u> – God's pressure is so strong, no one can resist. (Rom 10:18-21)

Perseverance of the Saints – to keep ourselves saved. Again, if Unconditional Election is true, Conditional Glorification cannot be true. If conditional glorification is true (which it is), Unconditional Election cannot be true. I believe in Salvation by Grace through Faith: (Eph 2:8-9) Offered by the Mercy of God: (Titus 3:5) Motivated by the Love of God: (Jn 3:16) I believe in Eternal Security: (Jn 3:36)(Jn 6:37) (Jn 10:28-30)

I believe Man has Free Will.

Man's Part is to Trust Christ and repent of His sins, God's part is to do the saving, imputing, and justifying.
