<u>Text</u>: Ezekiel 34:16

The Lies People Believe About Marriage:

LIE #1 "My happiness is the most important thing about my marriage."

- Happiness is not the purpose of marriage. (Col 3:17)
- Marriage does not guarantee happiness. (James 1:17)
- God has promised to provide everything I need. (Phil 4:19)
- Those who wait on the Lord always get His best. (Ps 37:4)

Lie #2: "If I don't love my spouse any longer, I should get a divorce."

• Love is a choice, (Deut 7:7-8)(1 Cor 13:4-8)(Rom 5:5)

Lie #3: "My spouse & I are incompatible."

- If I expect to be served,: (Mk 10:43b-45)
- A distinctive calling to be a "helper": (Genesis 2:18)
- We are like Jesus when we serve others. (Jn 13:5)

LIE #4: It's my job to change my mate.

• A godly life & prayer: 2 great influences: (James 5:16)

Lie #5: "I married the wrong person."

(Rom 8:28)(Rom 12:1)(Phil 2:13)(1 Cor 13:7)(Prov 16:7)

LIE #6 Submission Leads to Misery

We picture God's relationship with the church. (Eph5:21-25)

- A wife entrusts herself to the Living God: (Prov 21:1)
- A wife's submission: a powerful influence: (1 Pet 3:3-6)

LIE #8: Takeing the Initiative for a passive husband.

• If a woman jumps in to take the reins, (Genesis 16:1-2) Sara, Abraham, Hagar (Psalm 27:14)

Lie #9: "My private immorality does not affect my marriage."

Oneness in marriage is hijacked by sexual immorality. (1 Cor 6:15)

There are many ways to join oneself with a prostitute: (Matt 5:27-18)(1 Cor 6:18) "Flee fornication."

Lies People Believe About Sex & Sexuality:

LIE #10: I can't talk to anyone about it:

- Within Marriage, Any Biblical Healthy sex & sexuality is free of shame. (Gen 2:25)(Heb 13:4)(1 Jn 2:1)(Rom 8:1)
- Shame is Satan's tool to drive you from God: (Gen 3:10)
- God designed the Church to bring healing: (James 5:16)
- Your sexual past & current temptations do not define you. The cross of Christ is our Identity. (1 Cor 6:9-12*)

LIE #11: My sexuality is separate from my spirituality.

- 2 biological sexes to reflect His image: (Gen 1:26-27)
- Marriage & sexual intimacy reflect the oneness of God (Gen 2:24)
- Marriage & sex are a picture of the gospel. (Eph 5:31-32)

LIE #12 This is Who I Am

- Feelings are not facts. (Jer 17:9)(1 John 3:20)
- My identity is as an image bearer of God. (Gen 1:26-27)
- My identity = my Sexuality denies my purpose to glorify God. (Romans 1:20b-23)

LIE #13: God's Standards for Sex are Out of Date.

- God's standards were never "in style." (Gen 19:5; 38:22; Lev 18; 1 Cor 6:9)
- Sexual integrity is when my sexual choices are a consistent expression of my relational & spiritual commitments to God. (Eph 5:3)
- God does not want me to engage in any form of sex outside of marriage. (Lev 18:22; 1 Cor 6:9; 7:2; 1 Thes 4:3)

LIE #14: I Have to have an Outlet For My Sexual Desire

- My longing for intimacy is legitimate. (Genesis 4:1)
- My longing for sexual expression can be a snare. (Gal 5:1)
- <u>I can live w/o a sex, but not w/o the love of God</u>. (Prov 19:22)
- <u>Personal holiness is more important than any temporal pleasure</u> (Eph. 5:26-27).

Lie #15: "My spouse's sin is so bad that I need to get a divorce."

The truth is God can fix any & of our failures. (Joel 2:25)

Lie #16: "Breaking the marriage covenant won't hurt me or my children."

LIE #17: There's No Hope for My Marriage fixed."

(Mat 19:26) "but with God all things are possible"

We must combat the lies about marriage. (John 8:32)

• Marriage is a lifelong covenant that is intended to reflect the covenant-keeping heart of God. (Gen 2:18-24*)

(Ecc 5:4-6) God hates the Breaking of Vows (Mal 2:13-16) God "hateth putting away" (Mark 10:2-12)

- There is no marriage God cannot heal. (Matt 5:44; 18:21-22; Mk 11:25)
- God uses the rough edges of each partner in a marriage to conform the other to the image of Christ. (Eph 5:28-30)
- God's grace is sufficient to enable any person to be faithful to their spouse and to persevere in extending Christlike love and forgiveness. (2 Cor 12:9)
