The Lord's Supper is our "Feast" (1 Cor 5:8)

**I.** <u>Passover</u> is speaking of the 10<sup>th</sup> plague (Ex 11)

(Ex 12:5) Choose A Perfect Lamb

(Ex 12:6) Scrutinized, and Slain.

(Ex 12:46) No Broken Bones.

(Ex12:7, 13) Blood Applied (Heb 9:12,14)

(Ex 12:23) This was a Lamb of Deliverance.

(Lev 17:11) The Blood gave life. (1 Pet 1:18-19)

II. Christ is our Passover sacrificed for us.

He took Our/MY PLACE (Rom 5:8)(2 Cor 5:21)

III. The Passover was a yearly Memorial

(Ex 12:14) A yearly remembrance (Jn 1:29)(Heb 10:12)

OT characters did not see the NT Significance

(1 Pet 1:9-12) Prophets have enquired & searched

The Brazen Serpent- Picture of Christ on the Cross The Rock that gave water: Only To be Smitten 1x. (JN 7:37-39) The Water is the Holy Spirit.

The Passover was a forward look to Jesus Christ.

(Heb 9:12-14) The True Passover Lamb.

(Lk 22:15) He instituted it on the night they gathered together as a group to observe the Passover.

**Observed at Passover: (Matt 26:17-19)** 

The Lord's Supper: (1Cor 11:20)

Supper is the Evening meal. Matt 26:20 -21 Ex 12:6 1 Cor 5:7-8 Just as Jesus was our Passover lamb, the (Matt 26:26) Bread-Unlevened=Sinless (Jn 6:31,33,35,41,48, 51) Manna pictured Jesus!

(Matt 26:27) Cup Speaks of His Death (Matt 20:22-23)

(Prov 23:29-32; Is 28:7) Condemns liquor,

**What's in the cup:** *Fruit of the Vine: Symbolizes His Blood.* (Lev17:11)

Partakers of the Lords Supper?

The Saved-Those delivered from Judgement-Those that partook of the Lamb: Ex 12:8 Those under the Blood (Exodus 12:7,13) The Lost have no part of Christ's Death, burial, or Resurrection. (Ex 12:43-49) "No Stranger"

Proper Baptism - (Ex 12:43-48)

**Baptism-** is our Identifying Mark! (Col 2:8-12)

Church Membership (Ex 12:3,13) Lamb 4 a house!

(1 Cor 12:28) Apostles were the 1st Church

(Lk 22:14) Sat down with the twelve

(Mark 14:17, Matt 26:20)

(Acts 9:26) Paul, upon arriving at Jerusalem, wanted to "Join" the church.

(Matt 19:6) What does "Join" mean then?

## The Purpose of it: Memorial, keep the Church Pure

(1 Cor 11:17-18, 20, 33) (LK 22:19)(1 Cor 11:20)

(1 Cor 11:1-2) Not open for modification!

(Ex 13:10) it was to be kept yearly.
