- 4. Read (Isaiah 36-37) Take time to imagine the dread the residents of Jerusalem were feeling as they heard of the approaching Assyrian army. Think of your beautiful children, loved ones, home, and city.
- 5. Is your faith unwavering or are you struggling to trust in the Lord?
- 6. Then, on the day you heard of the miraculous death of 185,000 Assyrians & their army's subsequent retreat, *IMAGINE what your response would be?*
- 7. "Is there anything TOO hard for the Lord? NO, Nothing!"

- * Ask that God STIR you from your Comfort Zone.
