Forgiveness is a very mis-understood concept.

(Lk 17:1-4) <u>If you were expecting a Problem free Life, Sorry.</u> *How is this Possible? BY FAITH -* (Lk 17:5-6) *How do I forgive?*

I. <u>Understand that forgiveness is NOT</u> ...

- Denying you were hurt
- Forgetting or pushing it out of your mind
- An emotion or feeling
- Asking God to forgive you for being angry with the person
- Asking God to pardon the person who hurt you,

II. <u>Understand that forgiveness IS</u> ...
