## B. Zacchaeus Sought the Right Place: (vs 4)

 Jesus was looking for Him: (Vs 5)(Is 65:1) (Gen 3:8) God always Takes the Initiative: (Vs 10) God is the great initiator. (Rom 3:10-12) Man does not seek God (Jh 6:44)

## C. Zacchaeus Sought the Right Time: (Vs 6)

### D. Zacchaeus Sought the Right Confession:(Vs 8)

#### **Zacchaeus Benevolence was a Confession of His Salvation** (Is 45:22) Look & Live! & Be Saved (2 Cor 6:2)

### Jesus Brings Salvation to all who will receive Him: (Vs 9) (John 1:11-13)

### II. Jesus Comes to Bring Rewards: (Vs 13-19)

Parable illustrates Zacchaeus's story. (Vs 11-14) (1 Tim 1:11) (2 Cor 4:5-7) (Vs 15-16) There is coming a day of Accounting.
