Text: (Gen 32:24-32)

"Does God ever get tired of us saying no?"

Illus: The Answer is YES, but with a Resounding NO!

(Gen 6:3)

(Rom 10:19-21) God WOOs us like a lover. (James 4:5-8) The Holy Spirit "*Lusteth*"

I. Salvation: Takes Surrender

(Gen 32:24a) God came looking for Jacob

(Lk 19:10) He came seeking us.

(Acts 9:1-2) Saul wanted a relationship with God on his terms

(Acts 9:3-5) Jesus Came seeking Saul.

God gets on our trail like a hound dog: (John 6:44)

We are not guaranteed a tomorrow! (James 4:14)

We should accept God's offer now and not delay: (2 Cor 6:2)

Does God ever get tired of us saying no? YES! He does!

(Gen 32:25)God had to crippled Jacob to change Jacob's will (Ecc 9:4)(Ps 118:1-4) His *Mercy Endureth for ever*.

II. Separation: Takes Surrender

When Jacob became God's child, God gave him a new

Identity. (Gen 32:27-29)(Gen 25:26a)

Jacob stole Esau's Birthright: (Gen 25:29-34)

Jacob stole Esau's blessing, thus his Inheritance:

Explain the Story (Gen 27:34-41)(Gen 30:41-42)

God Met Jacob to confront him and give him One last opportunity to submit willingly. (Gen 32:27-28)

Does God ever get tired of us saying no? YES!

(Gen 32:25) God crippled Jacob to change Jacob's will.

When Jacob wrestled with God and submitted to God, God

gave him a new identity. (Gen 32:28)

God wants to be our identity. (2 Cor 5:17)(Gal 6:15)

(Eph 2: 6-13)(Eph 3:6,11)(John 8:38-44)

Many people will use these verses to excuse their behavior

(1 Cor 6:9-13) Explain the Society:

Our Identity in Christ is not based on our Behaviors.

(Matt 5:16, 45, 48)

(1 Cor 6:19-20) We Are NOT Our OWN!

(Rom 9:20-24)
