Respect the Name of God

Exodus 20:7; 1 Samuel 25:1-42

Another law that God gave Moses was, “Do not take the name of God in vain.” God wants you to love Him. God wants you to love His name. Say God’s name with love. Do not ever say God’s name when you are mad. God is happy when you say His name with love. But God is sad when you say His name when you are mad.

David loved God. He wrote songs to praise God. David pleased God. He was kind and loving.

David and his men protected some shepherds. They let nothing harm them. Later, the shepherds helped clip the thick wool from the sheep. The owner of the sheep, Nabal, had lots of food for all his workers.

David and his men had no food. David sent men to ask Nabal to share the food. Nabal treated them very badly. Nabal did not respect David as God’s man. He would not share the food.



SOMETHIN

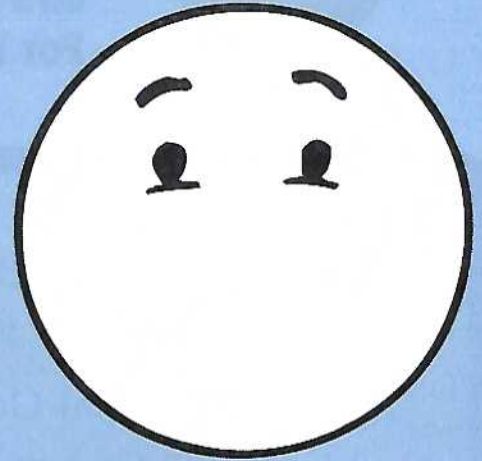
God's name is holy.

You might say, "Dear God."

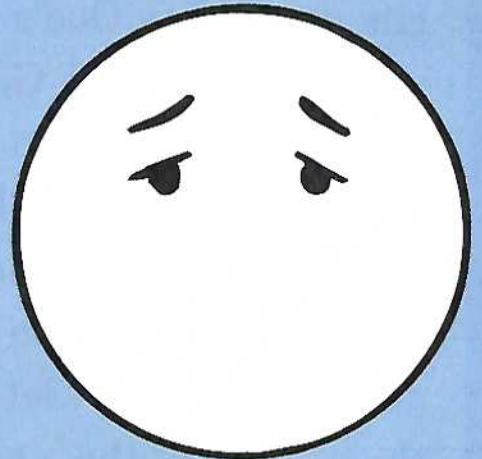
Do you say God's name in love when you pray?
