10th: (Vs 21)	A Desire Worth Controlling

1-4 Vertical Relationship

5-10 Horizontal Relationship

#10 causes us to violate the other 9.

Covetousness is Out of Control Desires of the Heart, Mind, & Flesh that Deceives us into fulfilling the Lusts.

The 10 Commandments to Save Us? NO! (Gal 3:11)

If Works could save, the 10 Comm would have! (Gal 3:21)

Not so Israel would “Become” His people, but because they “ARE” HIS people. (Gal 5:4)

God never started with the Law, came up with a better way. (Heb 10:8) (Gal 3:22)

Many believe the OT is a book of Law, NT is a book of Grace & that the OT has nothing to do with NT us. WRONG!

The WHOLE bible is a book of GRACE!

(Rom 4:13-16) (Gal 2:21)

WHY the Emphasis On The 10 Commandments!

10 Commandments Announces our Need for Christ:

(Rom 3:20-21)

10 Commandments Exposes Our Sin. (Rom 7:7)

10 Commandments Condemns Our Sin. (Rom 7:13)

Given to people that God had already redeemed.

We do not naturally believe we need a savior.

“Do you know that you are a Sinner?” **NO,**

“**OK, Let me tell you about the 10 Commandments**”

(James 2:10) “Guilty of all”

10 Commandments Points Us to Christ: (Gal 3:24-25)

(Rom 3:23) Missing the mark of God’s standard.

(1 Jn 3:4) Everyone who sins breaks the Law of God.

Did Jesus Live the 10 Commandments? YES!

(Jn 8:46) He challenged the Jews to point out His sin.

(2 Cor 5:21) *Knew no sin,*

(Heb 4:15) *Yet without sin.*

(1 Pet 2:22) *Who did no sin, neither was guile found in...*

(1 Jn 3:5) *and in him is no sin.*

Did Jesus Teach & Affirm the 10 Commandments: YES!

(Mk 10:19-23)

The Greatest Commandment: (Matt 22:35-38)

Jesus sums up the The 1st 4 Commandments.

The 2nd Greatest Commandment: (Matt 22:39-40)

Jesus sums up the The Last 6 Commandments. (Mk 12:28-34)

James refers to this as “The Royal Law”: (James 2:8)

Not just a NT Command.

(Lev 19:18) *thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself:*

(Lev 19:34) *Stranger...thou shalt love him as thyself;*

It seems it is getting harder to love others These Days

It is a sign of the end Times. (Matt 24:1)

We are afraid to love others. (Rom 1:28-31) (2 Tim 3:1-5)

Jesus Gives us a New Commandment: (John 13:34)

The Last Command before his arrest, death & Resurrection.

The NEW Part of the New Commandment is:

(Jn 13:34) **as I have loved you**, *that ye also love one another*

We Are to Love others “AS” Jesus Loves Us.

How can WE Love as Jesus Loves?

Jesus Gave Showed us How to Love OTHERS! (John 13)

A Selfless Love: (Jn 13:1-4) Jesus washes their feet.

(Lk 22:24-26) They had disputed who would be the Greatest.

(Jn 13:4) put on the garment of a slave.

(Phil 2:5-8) The Lord of Glory, laid aside his glory,

A Change of Mind is Required. (Phil 2:5)

GRACE: God Accepts Me

FAITH: I Accept that God Accepts ME.

PEACE: Because I have accepted that God has Accepted ME!

LOVE: Because God loves you, I can Love you!

FELLOWSHIP: You are free to accept me.

A Steadfast Love: (Jn 13:1) *“Loved them Unto the end”*

A Serving Love: (Jn 12:4-5)

Jesus met the greatest Injury with Service. (Matt 5:44)

Jesus Preached What He Practiced. (1 Jn 3:18)

A Sanctifying Love: (Jn 13:6-11)

(Jn 13:14-15) (Matt 25:40) When You do it to those who need

it, then you have done it unto Jesus!

Live it in His Name: (Col 3:17)

You are not your own: Bought with a Price. (1 Cor 6:20)

Reasonable Service: He has the right to ask. (Rom 12:1)

You Affirm His Deity by Our Obedience:

Show all that He is Lord by Our obedience.

Selfish Love Proclaims to the all He is not God:

(Ex 5:2) *“Who is the Lord that I should obey Him”*

Live it for His Glory: (1 Cor 10:31)

(1 Cor 6:20) Glorify God in your body.

What Am I communicating By My Behavior?

Do I want the things of God, or the World?

Do I Love the Lord or Myself?

A Lover of Pleasures or a Lover of God.

Live it Heartily: (Col 3:23)

Glorify God in your Attitude toward this: (1 Cor 6:20)

Parents, where are you in this? They are not going to follow through if We don't Love Others as Jesus Lives Us.

Reap What you Sow: (Gal 6:7-9)

Sow Righteousness: Sow a lot. (2 Cor 9:6)

Mom & Dad, You have to Love Selflessly:

A New Commandment: Love others as Jesus Loves US!
